

Buder Park FPV Quadcopter Guidelines

The area to the far west of the runway, along Meramec Street is set aside for use for FPV Quadcopter racing and practice.

To promote safety, education and growth of the hobby, the following guidelines will be in use.

- Safety first. Yield to unintentional spectator crossing into flying area until signage and borders are well established.
- Follow all currently established guidelines for Buder Park
- AMA will be required, as well as Buder Park permit
- All quadcopters will be registered in accordance with FAA requirements
- Altitude limit to tree tops in the surrounding area, so as not to interfere with airplane flight
- Fly within designated area as outlined on Buder map attached
- When flying FPV, a spotter will be used for safety purposes to ensure no spectators cross into the flight area.
- Do not walk into flight area while others are flying. Wait for them to land to retrieve downed craft

In addition to the above safety guidelines, the following usage guidelines will be followed

- Observe video frequencies in use. Consult with other flyers as to what video channel they are on so as to not interfere. In the future, a method of frequency control will be established similar to the flight control frequencies before 2.4 Ghz
- If flying FPV from the main runway please verify that your video channel is not in use by someone in the FPV quad racing area.
- Pilots will fly from the pilot area, and launch from designated start positions
